





## **COZY CUDDLE THROW IN 2 SIZES**

Throw finishes approximately 44" x 59" or 59" square. The larger size requirements are in ( ) **Supply List:** 

1-1/4 yards cuddle, (1 and 2/3 yards)

1-1/4 yards coordinating cuddle, (1 and 2/3 yards)

Seam allowance is 1/2".

Cuddle fabrics are slippery. Using a walking foot minimizes the fabric shift. If you don't have one, pin every 1" or less. Or use Wonder Clips.

Read through instructions before beginning project.



## **Directions:**

- 1. Lay your 2 fabrics right sides together. Trim so they both measure the same size.
- 2. Pin layers together.
- 3. To minimize stretch, leave a 6" opening on a selvage end for turning right side out.
- 4. Stitch layers together using a 1/2" seam allowance, backstitching at the beginning and end of your seam. Turn right side out.
- 5. Hand stitch the opening closed.
- 6. Topstitching is optional but gives a more professional look to your throw. To prepare for topstitching, pin about 5" in from the outside edge. With matching or coordinating thread, stitch around all 4 sides about 3" in from the edge.

Hints for sewing with Cuddle:

Make sure the nap of the fabrics are running in the same direction.

After cutting, place fabrics in the dryer on no or low heat to minimize the "fluff".

Use a 90/14 needle and a 3.5 or larger stitch.

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
