



SWEETHEART ARROW MAKE & TAKE

Supplies:

Sticks, dowels, straws or pipe cleaners 8"-12" long

Felt

Aileen's Clear Tacky Glue

Scissors

Frixion pens

Directions:

Reduce or enlarge the arrowhead and fletching as needed for the size of the arrow shaft.

Trace 2 arrowheads and 2 fletching pieces for each arrow. Cut out on drawn line.

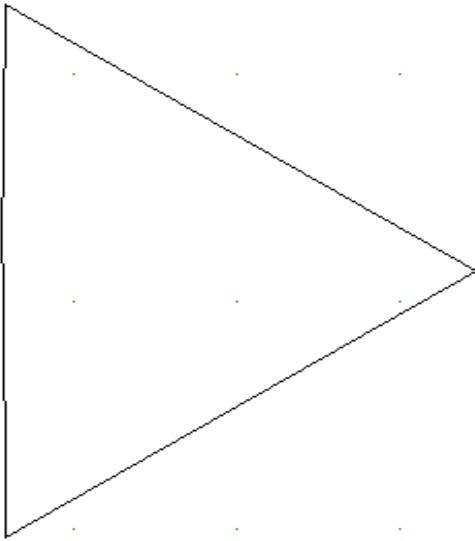
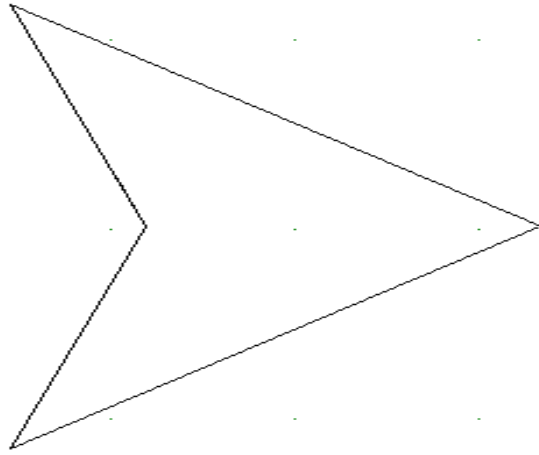
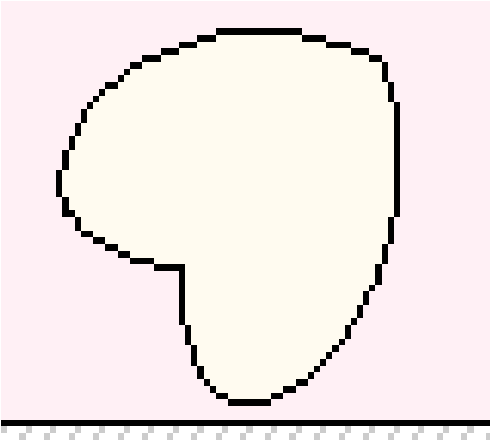
Run a thick bead of glue down the center of the fletching. Place arrow shaft on top of the glue bead. Run another bead of glue around the top and sides of the arrow shaft with a thinner application around the edges of the fletching. Place the second fletching piece on top of the glued area, matching edges and press firmly together.

Repeat the same steps using the arrowheads.

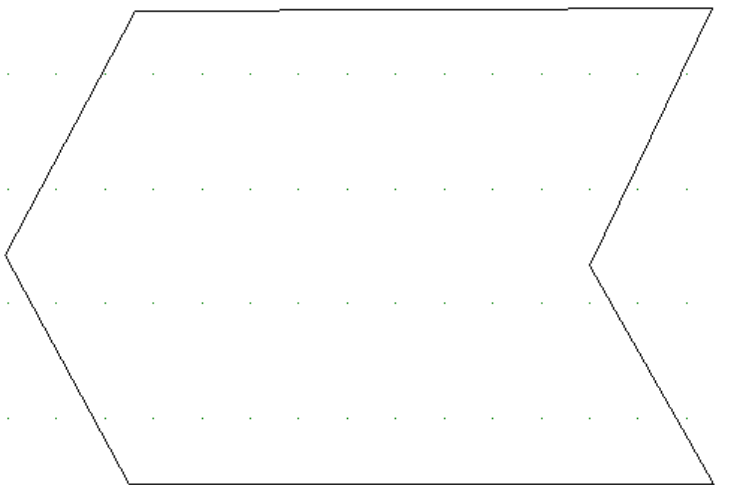
When the glue is dry, make narrow diagonal cuts in the fletching to create a feather look.
