



Madrid Cowl

Get ready to make a fashion statement with your new Madrid Cowl! Everyone will be asking where they can get one too, and you get to tell them that you made it yourself! And with the 3 Sisters Yarn, it will work up in no time!



Materials

2 hanks of 3 Sisters from Fair Isle in the color Sage

US Size 50 / 25mm crochet hook

Scissors

Measuring Tape

Very wide-eyed needle

Gauge

4"x4" 2sts x 1.5 rows

Finished Size

Your finished cowl should measure 13 inches long

and 18 inches wide

Recommendations

This cowl is made with a US Size 50 / 25mm crochet hook, but you may finger crochet very loosely if you prefer that method.

Abbreviations

Ch - Chain

St(s) - Stitch(es)

Sl St - Slip Stitch

HDC - Half Double Crochet

In FLO - Work in the front loop only

of the stitch SC - Single Crochet

Notes

This cowl is made in round, and you will join at the end of each round. The Ch1 at the end of the round does not count as a stitch.



Let's begin!

Ch 14. Join to the first ch with a Sl St being very careful not to twist your chain. Ch1.

Round 1: HDC in each stitch across. Join to first HDC with a Sl St. Ch1

Round 2: Working in FLO, HDC in each stitch around. Join to both loops of first HDC with a Sl St and Ch1

Round 3: Repeat Round 2

Round SC in each stitch around and join to first SC with a sl st. Fasten off.

Weave in all of your ends and turn your cowl inside out. And you're done!
