



Perler Bead Drink Covers

Supplies:

- Perler Beads in various colors
- Circle Perler Bead Pegboard
- Perler Bead Tweezers
- Iron

Directions:

1. Start by placing the Perler Beads on the pegboard in the center of the circle leaving the 5 middle pegs open.
2. Continue your circle design by changing colors. To fit on a wide mouth mason jar, each lid needs 7 circle layers. This should work for most glasses, but if you have certain drinkware in mind, measure to make sure you are making the lid large enough.
3. Heat your iron on medium temperature. Make sure to NOT use the steam feature.
4. Once it's hot, place the protective paper on top of the pegboard and iron for about 20 seconds moving it in a circular motion pressing the beads very gently.
5. Let cool and pull beads off the pegboard.
6. If you want the beads to have a more fused look or if you want them to be extra sturdy – flip them over and iron on the opposite side (place on the pegboard again and remember to use the paper).
7. We liked the pixilated look, so we only ironed one side on most of these projects.
