



Quarter for a Carrot

Supply List:

1/4 yd fabric (makes 6 carrots)

Poly fil stuffing

Needle and thread

60 degree triangle ruler

Green Wool felt square(12"x 18" makes 12 carrot tops)

1/4" seam allowance



Directions:

1. Using ruler cut one triangle out of fabric and fold in half right sides together and stitch along side. Fold carrot so that folded edge and stitched seam line up and trim across top to even edge. Turn right side out.
2. Stuff carrot to about 1/2" from open top. Turn raw edge down about 1/4" towards the inside of carrot and sew a basting stitch around and slightly close opening.
3. Cut two carrot tops and sew a basting stitch across bottom of each to gather and tuck inside top of carrot and pull opening shut and stitch through carrot tops to secure, tie off thread.
4. To make carrots different sizes simply cut a little more off when evening out top edge before turning.
