## Temperature Blanket Planner Page

While it is fun to start on the 1st of the month, you can start this project at anytime and you will get a lovely striped blanket that reflects the changing of the seasons. You can make this a year long project or just for a few months. Example; 4 months= about 240 knit rows. Approx width 44", length will be up to you based on how many days you choose to knit or crochet.

	Premier Everyday DK Cherry Red 1107-69	Above 96	<b>Circular Knitting Needles Size 6 (4.00 mm), 40" long Yarn Needle</b> <b>Knit Pattern:</b> <b>Row 1/Day 1:</b> Cast on 242 stitches, knit 1 row. <b>Day 2</b> and each day following Knit 2 rows (one out, one back to the start) in each day's Daily High Temperature. Continue until desired length.

	Premier Everyday DK Green Apple 1107-11	61-67	<b>CROCHET VERSION</b> <b>Crochet Hook Size G-6 (4mm) Yarn Needle</b> <b>Crochet Pattern:</b> <b>Row 1/Day 1</b> chain 165 single crochet in color appropriate for Day 1. Single crochet into the 2nd Chain from the hook. Continue single crochet till the end of the row. <b>Row 2 and beyond:</b> Turn your work and chain 1. Single crochet across, changing colors to match Daily High temperature. Continue until desired length.
