



## Oven Dress Dishtowel

### Supply List:

- 2 Fat Quarters for dress and ties
- 1 Dishtowel
- 10" x 13" scrap of fusible interfacing
- Optional trims and buttons for embellishment
- 1/4" seam allowance throughout



### Directions:

1. Using template provided cut (2) for dress top and one from interfacing. Fuse interfacing to one piece then put pieces right sides together and stitch around neck opening. Clip curves and turn right side out, press and topstitch around neck.
2. Take the top left side and lining left side and fold over to form a tube matching raw edges, right sides together. Stitch down side then clip corners and armhole for turning. Turn right side out and press. Repeat this for the other side.
3. Turn under 1/2" hem along the open bottom of top and press. Cut towel in half and gather raw edge to 6 1/2" and stitch in place. Insert gathered raw edge of towel into the open end so that it lays 1/2" inside and stitch.
4. Cut one strip 3" x 20" press all sides under 1/4". Fold strip in half lengthwise and press, then open and fold raw edges to fold line and fold back in half again and press. Mark center of tie band then center of dress front, match marks and topstitch tie band to front of dress.
5. Cut (2) pieces 3" x 8 1/2" for back ties and repeat step 4 then stitch to back sides of dress at waist.
6. Add decorative strip to bottom, rick rack, button or any embellishments to dress up your oven dress.
